TO RECOGNIZE KAYLE BROWNING FOR EARNING THE SILVER MEDAL FOR WOMEN'S TRAP SHOOTING AT THE 2020 SUMMER OLYMPIC GAMES IN TOKYO.

WHEREAS, Kayle Browning is an American sport shooter and is also an native Arkansan who has been shooting since she was eight (8) years old and has dreamed her whole life of going to the Olympics; and

WHEREAS, beginning her target shooting career in sporting clay shooting, Kayle Browning made the open All-American Team at twelve (12) years old and was an alternate for Team USA at the 2012 Olympic Games; and

WHEREAS, Kayle Browning took aim in the 2020 Summer Olympic Games in Tokyo for Team USA where she hit nineteen (19) straight shots after missing three (3) of her first four (4) shots; and

WHEREAS, at the end of the qualifying rounds that took place over two (2) days of trap shooting, Kayle Browning earned a silver medal in women's trap shooting, which makes her the first Arkansan and the first American to win a silver medal in women's trap shooting; and



WHEREAS, Kayle Browning showed her patriotism for this nation by holding a United States of American flag during the medal ceremony for women's trap shooting at 2020 Summer Olympic Games in Tokyo,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate recognize Kayle Browning for earning the silver medal for women's trap shooting at the 2020 Summer Olympic Games in Tokyo.
