## SENATE RESOLUTION

TO EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE  
NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO CONSIDER ONE (1) OR  
MORE BILLS TO DELAY THE START OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL  
YEAR UNTIL AFTER LABOR DAY.

### Subtitle

TO EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION  
OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO  
CONSIDER ONE (1) OR MORE BILLS TO DELAY  
THE START OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL YEAR UNTIL  
AFTER LABOR DAY.

WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 19, provides that, after the General Assembly has disposed of the business set forth in the Governor's proclamation to convene an extraordinary session, the General Assembly may, by a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to both houses, remain in session for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days for the purpose of transacting other legislative business; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has disposed of the matters set forth in the Governor's proclamation calling the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Third General



Assembly has completed action deemed to be necessary with respect to the business set forth in the Governor's proclamation to convene the extraordinary session.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly is extended in accordance with Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 19, and shall remain in session for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days for the purpose of considering one (1) or more bills to delay the start of the public school year until after Labor Day.
