WHEREAS, Major Douglas later became a paramedic with Metropolitan Emergency Medical Services and a volunteer with the Gravel Ridge Fire Department where he held the rank of Captain; and

WHEREAS, Major Douglas efficiently and effectively served Metropolitan Emergency Medical Services for twenty-eight (28) years; and

WHEREAS, Major Douglas assisted with the response to Hurricane Katrina in 2005; and

WHEREAS, as an organ and tissue donor, Major Douglas continued to serve



others even after his death by giving eight (8) organ recipients a second chance at life; and

WHEREAS, Major Douglas is survived by his wife Brandy Douglas; children Bralee (Lindsey), Kameron, and Mattie; his parents, Dean and Ernestine Douglas; his nephew James; his nieces; and a host of other relatives and friends,
