## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
CORRECTIONS - DIVISION OF CORRECTION; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS  
- DIVISION OF CORRECTION REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - LEASE PAYMENTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Corrections - Division of Correction the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 999 of 2021, for lease payments associated with debt service of facilities at Malvern and Newport, for additional prison beds, including the Special Needs Unit at Malvern, in a sum not to exceed .....\$14,105,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for lease payments associated with debt service on a 948-bed institution at Malvern, a 400-bed addition at the Grimes Unit at Newport, and 862-bed Special Needs Unit and addition to the Ouachita River Unit at Malvern, in a sum not to exceed .....\$573.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is



hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Corrections - Division of Correction the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for upgrades to the Tucker Water Treatment Plant, in a sum not to exceed .....\$320,450.

(B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for construction, replacement, and maintenance of equipment for East Arkansas Water Waste Project, in a sum not to exceed .....\$613,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for additional well to provide drinking water to Cummins & Varner Units, in a sum not to exceed ...\$370,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for construction, renovation and maintenance for the ORCU Waste Water Project, in a sum not to exceed .....\$200,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for construction, renovation and maintenance for the Varner Water Well, in a sum not to exceed .....\$600,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for construction, renovation and maintenance of facilities related to water treatment, water wells, and wastewater management for various units, in a sum not to exceed ....\$896,550.

(G) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for lethal fence upgrades at various units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$345,000.

(H) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for lethal fence upgrades at East Arkansas, Pine Bluff, RLW & MAX Units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$800,000.

(I) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (I) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for lethal fence upgrades at Cummins & Varner Units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$600,000.

(J) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (J) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for fence replacement at Delta,

North Central, Wrightsville & Ester Units, in a sum not to exceed  
.....\$1,255,000.

(K) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (K) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for replacement, upgrades and additions to current camera security systems at all units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$3,000,000.

(L) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (L) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for construction, renovation and maintenance of facilities and Central Warehouse, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,000,000.

(M) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (M) of Section 2 of Act 999 of 2021, for fire alarm upgrades at various units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$500,000.

(N) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for personal services and operating expenses of the Division of Correction - Ester Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$80.

(O) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for personal services and operating expenses of the Division of Correction - Female Work Release - Pine Bluff, in a sum not to exceed .....\$868,231.

(P) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for operating expenses of the Tucker Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$74,627.

(Q) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement and upgrade of existing facilities of the Division of Correction, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,220,279.

(R) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction to expand the existing visitation center at the McPherson Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$693.

(S) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction to expand the existing Administration Building at the McPherson Unit, in a sum not to

exceed .....\$134.

(T) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction of two armories at the Varner and Tucker Units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$28,960.

(U) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 213 of 2021, for replacement of the existing Water Treatment Plant at the Tucker Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,093,848.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - PANDEMIC AND CATASTROPHIC NEEDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Corrections - Division of Correction the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 999 of 2021, for contingency payment in case of pandemic, natural or catastrophic disasters, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,000,000.

SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Corrections - Division of Correction the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction, renovation and major maintenance of facilities and Central Warehouse of the Division of Correction, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,000,000.

SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the Division of Correction Prison Industry Fund, for the Department of Corrections - Division of Correction the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 999 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement, and upgrade of the Department of Corrections - Various Industry

Projects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 213 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement and upgrade of the Division of Correction - Various Industry Projects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$6,312.

(C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 4 of Act 213 of 2021, for various industry projects including storage at the Wrightsville Unit near the industry buildings, in a sum not to exceed .....\$150,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 4 of Act 213 of 2021, for various industry projects for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement, and upgrade of the Division of Correction, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 4 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction, renovation and major maintenance of facilities and Central Warehouse, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,000,000.

SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS FARM PROJECTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the Division of Correction Farm Fund, for the Department of Corrections - Division of Correction the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 999 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement, and upgrade of the Department of Corrections - Various Farm Projects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement, and upgrade of the Division of Correction - Various Farm Projects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction of grain

storage bins at the East Arkansas Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$200,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction of grain storage bins at the Tucker Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$200,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for renovation of the current dairy facility and replacement of equipment, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,799,800.

(F) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction of grain storage bins at Cummins, Tucker and East Arkansas Units, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,430,250.

(G) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for maintenance and repair to upgrade the existing feed mill at the Cummins Unit, in a sum not to exceed .....\$889,750.

(H) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for Irrigation Project at Tucker/Cummins, in a sum not to exceed .....\$110,000.

(I) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for various farm projects for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement, and upgrade of the Division of Correction, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

SECTION 7. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2022.
