BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
STATE OF ARKANSAS:

WHEREAS, On February 24, 2022, the Russian Federation launched an
unprovoked invasion of the sovereign nation of Ukraine; and

WHEREAS, the United States has the ability to take economic actions
against the Russian Federation and its leaders who are responsible for this
unjust invasion of the sovereign nation of Ukraine; and

WHEREAS, the United States can expel Russian oligarchs, freeze assets
of Russian oligarchs and political leaders who supported the invasion of the
sovereign nation of Ukraine, and take other similar actions to deter further
unprovoked aggression from the Russian Federation against its neighbors and
to penalize the Russian Federation for its unjust invasion of the sovereign
nation of Ukraine,



NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate condemn the actions of the Russian Federation taken against the sovereign nation of Ukraine and call for the United States to expel Russian oligarchs, freeze assets of Russian oligarchs and political leaders who supported the invasion of the sovereign nation of Ukraine, and take all other similar actions that would deter the Russian Federation from further unprovoked aggression towards its neighbors and to penalize the Russian Federation for its unjust invasion of the sovereign nation of Ukraine.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon its adoption, a copy of this resolution be presented to President Joseph Biden; United States Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer; United States Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell; Speaker of the United States House of Representatives Nancy Pelosi; United States House of Representatives Minority Leader Kevin McCarthy; United States Senators John Boozman and Tom Cotton; and United States Representatives French Hill, Rick Crawford, Steve Womack, and Bruce Westerman by the Secretary of the Senate.
