WHEREAS, on March 6, 1947, the Bureau of Legislative Research was created as part of the same legislation that created the Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Legislative Research began with only a director, a stenographer, and a couple of administrative assistants to assist the legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Legislative Research was originally created for a twenty (20) year period and its original duties included providing legislative services to the Legislative Council, submitting itemized budgets for each state agency, drafting bills with the assistance of the University of Arkansas School of Law, and assisting the Governor in acquiring factual information concerning various matters; and

WHEREAS, since its creation seventy-five (75) years ago, the Bureau of Legislative Research has faithfully served the General Assembly in supporting the mission of the General Assembly,



NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
