For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT REGARDING HUNTING LICENSES AND FISHING LICENSES FOR RESIDENTS; TO AUTHORIZE A MINOR WHO IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A HUNTING LICENSE OR FISHING LICENSE TO PAY THE RESIDENT FEE WHEN VISITING A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

REGARDING HUNTING LICENSES AND FISHING LICENSES FOR RESIDENTS; AND TO AUTHORIZE A MINOR WHO IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A HUNTING LICENSE OR FISHING LICENSE TO PAY THE RESIDENT FEE WHEN VISITING A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-42-104, concerning hunting and fishing licenses for residents, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(f) A minor who is required to obtain a hunting license or fishing license under this section who resides out-of-state but is visiting a parent or legal guardian who resides in this state is considered a resident under this section and shall pay the resident fee for the hunting license or fishing license.
