AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PARKING PRIVILEGES
FOR A PERSON ISSUED A DISABLED VETERAN SPECIAL
LICENSE PLATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PARKING
PRIVILEGES FOR A PERSON ISSUED A DISABLED
VETERAN SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-15-316(b), concerning disabled veterans under the Access to Parking for Persons with Disabilities Act, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) A vehicle that meets the following conditions is permitted parking privileges in those areas designated for parking only by a person with a disability under this subchapter:

~~(1)(A)~~ The vehicle must display a disabled veteran special license plate issued to a disabled veteran by the Department of Finance and Administration under § 27-24-204(a)(1), § 27-24-204(a)(2), or § 27-24-204(a)(3), ~~or a valid disabled veteran license plate issued by another state;~~
~~and~~

~~(2)(B)~~ The vehicle must be in use for the actual transporting of a disabled veteran; ~~and~~

(C) The vehicle must display a special certificate or temporary special certificate issued by the Office of Motor Vehicle under



this subchapter.

(2) However, a vehicle with a valid disabled veteran license plate issued by another state is permitted parking privileges under this subchapter if the vehicle is being used for the actual transporting of a disabled veteran as required by subdivision (b)(1)(B) of this section.
