### For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING JURY SERVICE; TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION FROM JURY SERVICE FOR PERSONS SEVENTY (70) YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER; TO CREATE LYNA GAYLE'S LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING JURY SERVICE; TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION FROM JURY SERVICE FOR PERSONS SEVENTY (70) YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER; AND TO CREATE LYNA GAYLE'S LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Lyna Gayle's Law".

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-31-103(d), concerning exemptions from jury service, is amended to read as follows:

(d) A person who is ~~eighty (80)~~ seventy (70) years of age or older may voluntarily exempt himself or herself from or decline to participate in jury service at any time.
