AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ON A PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY BY AN EMPLOYEE OF A UTILITY, TELECOMMUNICATIONS, OR CABLE COMPANY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ON A PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY BY AN EMPLOYEE OF A UTILITY, TELECOMMUNICATIONS, OR CABLE COMPANY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-21-106(a)(5), concerning the operation of an all-terrain vehicle on a public street or highway, is amended to read as follows:

(5) An employee or agent of a utility, telecommunications, or cable company ~~working during a time of emergency or severe weather~~ may operate an all-terrain vehicle on a public street or highway while he or she is:

(A) Performing a function directly related to the operation of the utility, telecommunications, or cable company; or

(B) Working during a time of emergency or severe weather;
