AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING DEADLINES FOR
SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO SUBMIT THE RATE OF TAX FOR A
SCHOOL ELECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING DEADLINES FOR
SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO SUBMIT THE RATE OF
TAX FOR A SCHOOL ELECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-14-111(i), concerning candidate filing procedures and school district rate of tax submission, is amended to read as follows:

(i) The school district shall file the language required to submit the rate of tax for the school district to the voters during the annual school election with the county clerk of the county in which the school district is domiciled for administrative purposes as soon as that language becomes available but no later than ~~sixty (60)~~ seventy-two (72) days before the annual school election, except in years in which the President of the United States shall appear on the ballot at the general election, and then the school district shall file the language with the county clerk eighty-nine (89) days before the annual school election.
