AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY DAMAGE TO A VEHICLE INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT REQUIRES AN ACCIDENT REPORT BY LAW ENFORCEMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY DAMAGE TO A VEHICLE INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT REQUIRES AN ACCIDENT REPORT BY LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-53-202(a), concerning required accident reports and supplemental reports, is amended to read as follows:

27-53-202. Reports of accidents required – Supplemental reports.

(a)(1) The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person or total property damage to an apparent extent of ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ three thousand dollars (\$3,000) or more shall notify the nearest law enforcement agency immediately.

(2) All persons involved in the accident shall make themselves readily available to the investigating agency's officer or officers.
