AN ACT TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF AGGRAVATED ASSAULT IN
A PUBLIC CHANGING FACILITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF AGGRAVATED
ASSAULT IN A PUBLIC CHANGING FACILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 13, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

5-13-214. Aggravated assault in public changing facility.

(a)(1) As used in this section, "public changing facility" means a facility or enclosed space that is held out as open to the public and designed to be used at a time during which a person may be in a state of undress in the presence of other persons.

(2) "Public changing facility" includes without limitation a restroom, bathroom, locker room, or shower room.

(b) A person commits aggravated assault in a public changing facility if he or she purposely engages in conduct that creates a substantial risk of serious physical injury to another person while in a public changing facility.

(c) Aggravated assault in a public changing facility is a Class D felony.
