AN ACT CONCERNING THE PREPARED SCHEDULE OF PROPERTY
ORDERED WHEN A JUDGMENT CALLS FOR PROPERTY SUBJECT TO
EXECUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-66-221 is amended to read as follows:
16-66-221. Schedule of property – Filing.

(a) Whenever ~~any resident of this state has~~ any final judgment order of a court of record is entered against a judgment debtor, the judgment debtor ~~him or her, he or she~~ shall prepare a schedule, verified by affidavit, of all ~~his or her~~ the judgment debtor's property, both real and personal, including moneys, bank accounts, rights, credits, and choses in action held by ~~himself or herself~~ the judgment debtor or others for ~~him or her~~ the judgment debtor and specify the particular property which ~~he or she~~ the judgment debtor claims as exempt under the provisions of the law.

(b) The schedule shall be filed with the clerk of the court in which the final judgment order was rendered within forty-five (45) days of entry of the final judgment order.

(c) (1) All final judgment orders of a court of record in this state



shall include a provision requiring the judgment debtor to comply with the requirements of this section.

(2) However, the absence of the provision from a final judgment shall not invalidate the judgment.
