AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING VETERINARY
TECHNICIANS AND VETERINARY TECHNOLOGISTS; TO AMEND
THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR LICENSURE FOR VETERINARY
TECHNICIANS AND VETERINARY TECHNOLOGISTS; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR LICENSURE
FOR VETERINARY TECHNICIANS AND VETERINARY
TECHNOLOGISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-101-306(b)(2)(B)(i), concerning a copy of the applicant's diploma or equivalent accompanying an application for certification as a veterinary technician or veterinary technologist, is amended to read as follows:

(B)(i) A copy of the applicant's diploma or its equivalent from a college-level program accredited by the American Veterinary Medical Association or a Bachelor of Science degree in Animal Science with a preveterinary emphasis.
