For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CERTAIN PERMITS; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO CERTAIN DISTILLERS, MANUFACTURERS, OR SMALL FARM WINERIES IN A DRY AREA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CERTAIN PERMITS; AND TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO CERTAIN DISTILLERS, MANUFACTURERS, OR SMALL FARM WINERIES IN A DRY AREA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-602, concerning a distiller or manufacturer permit, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(1) The division may issue a permit under this section to a distiller or a manufacturer in a dry area if the distiller or manufacturer sells exclusively to wholesalers as authorized under § 3-8-203.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 3-5-1602, concerning the licensing of small farm wineries, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(e) The board may issue a license under this section to a small farm winery in a dry area if the small farm winery sells exclusively to



wholesalers as authorized under § 3-8-203.
