For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES; TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY ACCELERATOR ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL BUSINESSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR INCENTIVES UNDER THE ACT; TO AMEND THE CONSOLIDATED INCENTIVE ACT OF 2003 TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL BUSINESSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR INCENTIVES UNDER THE ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO ALLOW CERTAIN SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL BUSINESSES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES UNDER THE ARKANSAS BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY ACCELERATOR ACT AND THE CONSOLIDATED INCENTIVE ACT OF 2003.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-3-603(3)(B), concerning the businesses and industries included in the definition of "eligible applicant" under the Arkansas Business and Technology Accelerator Act, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(viii) A business primarily engaged in operating combustors and incinerators for the disposal of nonhazardous solid waste, as classified in code 562213 of the 2022 North American Industry Classification System.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2703(8), concerning the businesses and industries included in the definition of "eligible businesses" under the Consolidated Incentive Act of 2003, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(L) Businesses primarily engaged in operating combustors and incinerators for the disposal of nonhazardous solid waste, as classified in code 562213 of the 2022 North American Industry Classification System.
