AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR RAPE;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR
RAPE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-1-109(a)(1)(D), concerning offenses for which prosecution may be commenced at any time, is amended to read as follows:

(D) Rape, § 5-14-103, ~~if the victim was a minor at the time of the offense;~~
