WHEREAS, Damon and Margaret Reed purchased the 1828 Morrow family farmstead which is comprised of a four (4) room log cabin, smokehouse, outhouse, watering trough, and Morrow Family Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the Reverend George Morrow and his wife, Elizabeth Morrow, originally built the family farmstead; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow farmstead is located at 16995 Hale Mountain Road, Morrow, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, during the past eighteen (18) months, Damon and Margaret have worked tirelessly in restoring the 1828 log cabin; and

WHEREAS, while the Morrow farmstead was already listed on the Arkansas State Register of Historic Places and due to the incredible amount of labor by the Reeds, the Morrow farmstead has been placed on the National Register of Historic Places; and



WHEREAS, the Morrow farmstead buildings date to the late nineteenth or early twentieth century and were all built by the Morrow family,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

THAT the House of Representatives recognize Damon and Margaret Reed for their work in restoring the Morrow farmstead.
