WHEREAS, on January 28, 2023, the Trinity Catholic Middle School Science Bowl team competed in the United States Department of Energy National Middle School Science Bowl regional competition at the University of Arkansas, Fort Smith; and

WHEREAS, the Trinity Catholic Middle School Science Bowl team competed against charter schools, public schools, and other private schools and placed first in the United States Department of Energy National Middle School Science Bowl regional competition; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Energy National Science Bowl is a nationwide academic competition that tests students' knowledge in all areas of science and mathematics; and

WHEREAS, middle school student teams from diverse backgrounds are comprised of four (4) students, one (1) alternate, and a teacher who serves



as an advisor and coach; and

WHEREAS, these teams face off in a fast-paced question-and-answer format, being tested on a range of science disciplines including biology, chemistry, Earth science, physics, energy, and math; and

WHEREAS, beginning in January this year, more than five thousand (5,000) middle school students competed in fifty (50) middle school regional Science Bowl tournaments; and

WHEREAS, the Trinity Catholic Middle School Science Bowl team members are coached by Mrs. Tia Marsh who has spent countless hours preparing the team for the United States Department of Energy National Middle School Science Bowl regional competition; and

WHEREAS, the Trinity Catholic Middle School Science Bowl team members are seventh graders Elliot Bray, Henry Morrison, McCrae Price, and Lucas Woods, and sixth grader Isabella Garrett; and

WHEREAS, most teams at the United States Department of Energy National Middle School Science Bowl Regional competition in Fort Smith were eighth graders; and

WHEREAS, the Trinity Catholic Middle School Science Bowl team will be traveling to Washington D.C., for the 2023 United States Department of Energy National Middle School Science Bowl National Finals,
