HOUSE RESOLUTION

TO RECOGNIZE THE INALIENABLE RIGHT TO LIFE, PROPERTY,
AND DEFENSE, AND THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS IN
ARKANSAS; AND TO PROCLAIM THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR
ARMS DAY IN ARKANSAS.

TO RECOGNIZE THE INALIENABLE RIGHT TO
LIFE, PROPERTY, AND DEFENSE, AND THE
RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS IN ARKANSAS;
AND TO PROCLAIM THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND
BEAR ARMS DAY IN ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, § 2 guarantees the right to life, property, and defense; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, § 5 guarantees citizens of the State of Arkansas the right to keep and bear arms; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Arkansas shall have the right to keep and bear arms for their common defense; and



WHEREAS, the Arkansas Constitution states that these rights are excepted out of the general authority of the government; and

WHEREAS, citizens' involvement in exercising these rights through grassroots activism has led to Arkansas leading the nation as one of the most gun-friendly states in America,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House of Representatives recognize the inalienable rights as set out in the Arkansas Constitution and proclaim the Right to Keep and Bear Arms Day in Arkansas.
