WHEREAS, the Firehouse Museum & Hostel of Arkansas is located at 1201
Commerce Street in Little Rock, Arkansas;

WHEREAS, Arkansas has one of the highest fire death rates per one
hundred thousand (100,000) persons in America; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas has over seventeen thousand (17,000) paid and
volunteer firefighters in over one thousand (1,000) fire departments; and

WHEREAS, hostelling was created to provide safe and economic lodging
for millions of world travelers seeking to visit countries with clean and
affordable lodging; and

WHEREAS, Hostelling Arkansas was formed in 2003 and obtained former
Fire Station 2 in the MacArthur Park Historic District in Little Rock; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, Hostelling Arkansas opened the Firehouse Museum &
Hostel of Arkansas to teach fire prevention and safety to all visitors,



tourists, and hostellers in the State; and

WHEREAS, the Firehouse Museum & Hostel of Arkansas has seen unprecedented interest in its mission and plans to expand the facilities to over twelve thousand (12,000) square feet,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House of Representatives recognize the Firehouse Museum & Hostel of Arkansas for its contributions to the State of Arkansas.
