SENATE BILL 231

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT OF CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AFTER LEAVING OFFICE; TO RESTRICT A CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICER FROM CERTAIN TYPES OF EMPLOYMENT FOR TWO YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT OF CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AFTER LEAVING OFFICE; AND TO RESTRICT A CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICER FROM CERTAIN TYPES OF EMPLOYMENT FOR TWO YEARS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-1-402(f)(1), concerning restrictions on other employment, is amended to read as follows:

(f)(1) A former member of the General Assembly shall not take the following actions until two (2) years after the expiration of the term of office for which he or she was elected:

(A) Register as a lobbyist under § 21-8-601 et seq.; ~~or~~

(B) Enter into employment as the director of an:

(i) Educational cooperative under The Public School Educational Cooperative Act of 1981, § 6-13-901 et seq.; or

(ii) Area agency on aging; or

(C)(i) Enter into employment as a consultant or director with a firm, business, association, or other private entity with the primary purpose of lobbying an elected official of Arkansas.



(ii) Subdivision (f)(1)(C)(i) of this section does not apply to:

(a) The lobbying of an elected federal official or an elected official of another state; or

(b) Other lobbying activities at the national level.
