# A Bill

SENATE BILL 281

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING REPEAT OFFENDERS AND PAROLE ELIGIBILITY; TO REQUIRE A PERSON WHO HAS THREE OR MORE PREVIOUS COMMITMENTS TO STATE INCARCERATION TO SERVE AT LEAST EIGHTY PERCENT OF HIS OR HER SENTENCE FOR HIS OR HER NEXT COMMITMENT TO STATE INCARCERATION BEFORE BEING ELIGIBLE FOR PAROLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING REPEAT OFFENDERS AND PAROLE ELIGIBILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the law concerning repeat offenders and parole eligibility, to require a person who has three (3) or more previous commitments to state incarceration to serve at least eighty percent (80%) of his or her sentence for his or her next commitment to state incarceration before being eligible for parole, and for other purposes.
