For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE DIVISION OF WORKFORCE SERVICES LAW; TO AMEND AN EXCLUSION FROM THE DEFINITION OF "EMPLOYMENT" WITHIN THE DIVISION OF WORKFORCE SERVICES LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE DIVISION OF WORKFORCE SERVICES LAW; AND TO AMEND AN EXCLUSION FROM THE DEFINITION OF "EMPLOYMENT" WITHIN THE DIVISION OF WORKFORCE SERVICES LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-10-210(f)(21), concerning exclusions from the definition of "employment" in the Division of Workforce Services Law, is amended to read as follows:

(21)(A) Services performed as personal care services for a certified home- and community-based health services provider licensed under § 20-10-2301 et seq., unless the provider is a state or local government entity or federally recognized Indian tribe as described in 26 U.S.C § 3306(c)(7) or a nonprofit organization as described in 26 U.S.C § 3309(a)(1).

(B) Subdivision (f)(21)(A) of this section is retroactive to January 1, 2010~~+~~.

(C) This subdivision (f)(21) shall expire on September 30, 2023.
