AN ACT REGARDING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; TO AMEND THE  
LAW RELATED TO ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS SOLD BY THE HOLDER  
OF A LIQUOR PERMIT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

REGARDING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; AND TO  
AMEND THE LAW RELATED TO ADDITIONAL  
PRODUCTS SOLD BY THE HOLDER OF A LIQUOR  
PERMIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-218(a)(2), concerning additional products a permittee may have at the permitted premises, is amended to read as follows:

(2) However, the permittee may have:

(A) ~~tobacco~~ Tobacco products;

(B) ~~mixers~~ Mixers;

(C) ~~soft~~ Soft drinks;

(D) ~~consumables~~ Consumables and edible products that complement alcoholic beverages;

(E) Clothing and other promotional or marketing merchandise with logos or graphics of the permittee's business; and

(F) ~~other~~ Other items customarily associated with the retail package sale of the liquors.
