For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE POSSESSION OF FENTANYL TEST STRIPS; TO EXCLUDE FENTANYL TEST STRIPS FROM THE DEFINITION OF "DRUG PARAPHERNALIA" UNDER THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO EXCLUDE FENTANYL TEST STRIPS FROM THE DEFINITION OF "DRUG PARAPHERNALIA" UNDER THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-64-101(12), concerning the definition of "drug paraphernalia" under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(D) "Drug paraphernalia" does not include a disposable, single-use test strip that can detect the presence of fentanyl or fentanyl analogs in a substance;
