For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ABORTION-INDUCING DRUGS SAFETY ACT; TO ADD REVOCATION OF A PHYSICIAN'S MEDICAL LICENSE TO THE PROFESSIONAL SANCTIONS AUTHORIZED FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABORTION-INDUCING DRUGS SAFETY ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE ABORTION-INDUCING DRUGS SAFETY ACT; AND TO ADD REVOCATION OF A PHYSICIAN'S MEDICAL LICENSE TO THE PROFESSIONAL SANCTIONS AUTHORIZED FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABORTION-INDUCING DRUGS SAFETY ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-16-1507, concerning the civil remedies and professional sanctions under the Abortion-Inducing Drugs Safety Act, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(f) Upon a finding of the Arkansas State Medical Board that a physician failed to comply with the requirements of this subchapter, the board shall revoke the physician's medical license.
