## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW; TO  
EXEMPT CERTAIN COMMODITIES AND SERVICES UNDER THE  
ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW;  
AND TO EXEMPT CERTAIN COMMODITIES AND  
SERVICES UNDER THE ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT  
LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-203(14), concerning the definition of "exempt commodities and services" under the Arkansas Procurement Law, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(FF) Commodities procured by the State Parks Division to furnish and supply overnight lodging facilities with amenities, linens, furniture, and general decor.
