## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE LIGHTING  
REQUIREMENTS FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING LIGHTING  
REQUIREMENTS FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-36-208, concerning special restrictions on lamps, is amended to add additional subsections to read as follows:

(d) The prohibition on the use of flashing lights under subsection (c) of this section does not prohibit the placement or the use of a high-mounted stop lamp on a motor vehicle that is not listed in subdivision (c)(1)-(5) of this section.

(e) As used in this section, "high-mounted stop lamp" means a stop lamp with a light that pulses and varies in intensity up to four (4) times but does not deactivate when the motor vehicle brakes for two (2) seconds or less.
