For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW THAT REQUIRES HOLOCAUST EDUCATION; TO ESTABLISH HOLOCAUST EDUCATION WEEK IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW THAT REQUIRES HOLOCAUST EDUCATION; AND TO ESTABLISH HOLOCAUST EDUCATION WEEK IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-16-154, concerning Holocaust education, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(d)(1) To educate students about the significance and history of the Holocaust, the last full week of classes in January in Arkansas public schools shall be designated as "Holocaust Education Week".

(2) The state board shall:

(A) Notify all public schools before the beginning of each school year of the dates designated as "Holocaust Education Week" required under subdivision (d)(1) of this section; and

(B) Encourage all public schools to teach Holocaust education during the dates designated as "Holocaust Education Week" required under subdivision (d)(1) of this section.
