SENATE RESOLUTION

TO RECOGNIZE THE MALVERN LEOPARDS FOOTBALL TEAM AS
THE CLASS 4A STATE CHAMPIONS.

TO RECOGNIZE THE MALVERN LEOPARDS
FOOTBALL TEAM AS THE CLASS 4A STATE
CHAMPIONS.

WHEREAS, the Malvern Leopards bested the Harding Academy Wildcats to take the Class 4A state football championship with a score of 64-39 at War Memorial Stadium in Little Rock, Arkansas, on Saturday, December 10, 2022, claiming the team's first state title in twenty-nine (29) years and the second in school history; and

WHEREAS, following two (2) inclement weather delays totaling three and one-half hours (3 1/2), the two (2) teams were able to get back on the field and combined for one thousand one hundred thirty-seven (1,137) yards of offense, which is the second highest offense in Arkansas state championship game history; and

WHEREAS, unforeseen scheduling changes prior to the beginning of the regular season left Malvern with only three (3) home games; and

WHEREAS, between the regular season games and playoff games, the team traveled approximately one thousand seven hundred (1,700) miles of road trips, including trips to Riverview; Glen Rose; Hernando, Mississippi; Waldron; Mena; Nashville; Lamar; Warren; and War Memorial Stadium,



NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate congratulate and recognize the Malvern Leopards football team as the Class 4A state champions.
