WHEREAS, the members of emergency medical services teams have served on the front lines caring for critical patients during the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value and the accomplishments of selected individuals who epitomize the spirit of emergency medical services,



NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate proclaims March 8, 2023, as "Stars of Life Day" and recognize the individuals who are being awarded as "Arkansas EMS Stars of Life".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT that upon adoption of this resolution, a copy shall be provided to each Arkansas EMS Star of Life recipient by the Secretary of the Senate.
