WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell won the title while competing as Ms. Dogwood; and

WHEREAS, as the first Miss Arkansas from Harrison, Ms. Mitchell won a scholarship for thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) and more than seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) in awards, wardrobe, transportation, and gifts; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell has made and continues to make appearances throughout the state promoting her personal platform of "A Responsible Digital You"; and

WHEREAS, during the Miss Arkansas competition, Ms. Mitchell won the Sarah Slocum Overall Private Interview Award, the Bill Tarkington Overall Evening Gown Award, the Asher Ray Mentor Award, the "All Grown Up" Award, and the Grace Scholarship; and

WHEREAS, during the arrival ceremonies it was announced that Ms. Mitchell won the Scott Landers Business Profession Marketplace Scholarship and during the preliminary competition for the Sigma Group won the



Preliminary Evening Gown award, the Preliminary On-Stage Interview award, and the Preliminary Talent award; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell competed for the title of Miss America 2023 in December, 2022 in Uncasville, Connecticut; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell is not new to these competitions having competed in the Outstanding Teen program as Miss Northwest Arkansas' Outstanding Teen, North Central Arkansas' Outstanding Teen, and Miss Lakes of the Northwest Outstanding Teen, and was Diamond State Princess for Miss University of Arkansas in 2007; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell received her Bachelor of Business Administration from the University of Central Arkansas in 2019 and received her Master of Health Administration from John Brown University in 2022; and
