SENATE RESOLUTION

TO EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE
NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR A PERIOD NOT
EXCEEDING FIFTEEN (15) DAYS UNDER ARKANSAS
CONSTITUTION, ARTICLE 6, § 19, FOR THE PURPOSE OF
CONSIDERING LEGISLATION TO REPEAL THE ARKANSAS DATA
CENTERS ACT OF 2023.

Subtitle

TO EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION
OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO
CONSIDER LEGISLATION TO REPEAL THE
ARKANSAS DATA CENTERS ACT OF 2023.

WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 19, provides that, after the General Assembly has disposed of the business set forth in the Governor's proclamation to convene an extraordinary session, the General Assembly may, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to both houses, remain in session for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days for the purpose of transacting other legislative business; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has disposed of the matters set forth in the Governor's proclamation calling the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly,



NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly has completed action deemed to be necessary with respect to the business set forth in the Governor's proclamation to convene the First Extraordinary Session.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly is extended as provided in Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 19, and shall remain in session for a period not exceeding fifteen (15) days for the purpose of considering legislation to repeal the Arkansas Data Centers Act of 2023.
