WHEREAS, during her time at the Community Mental Health Center, Brenda Huett received her Psychiatric Certification from the American Nurses Credentialing Center; and

WHEREAS, after leaving the Community Mental Health Center, Brenda Huett worked as a traveling nurse for ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, Brenda Huett enjoyed traveling nursing and the different assignments she took on and the places she was able to explore, including assignments in:

- (1) Maine;
- (2) The Virgin Islands;
- (3) Hawaii;
- (4) Louisiana;
- (5) Nebraska; and
- (6) Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, after working as a traveling nurse, Brenda Huett decided to stay closer to home and accepted a job with the Department of Health's regional flu team, working during flu season for the last ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, Brenda Huett has also been working as a nurse in the H. Elvin Shuffield Capitol Infirmary during the legislative sessions for ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, Brenda Huett is a member of the National Nurses Honor Guard Coalition and is active in the Saline County Chapter, feeling honored to be a part of an organization that honors her fellow nurses; and
