## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE INCIDENTAL SALE OF GOAT MILK, SHEEP MILK, AND WHOLE MILK THAT HAS NOT BEEN PASTEURIZED; TO CLARIFY THAT THE INCIDENTAL SALE OF RAW MILK IS NOT LIMITED TO A SALE ON THE FARM; AND OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE INCIDENTAL SALE OF GOAT MILK, SHEEP MILK, AND WHOLE MILK THAT HAS NOT BEEN PASTEURIZED; AND TO CLARIFY THAT THE INCIDENTAL SALE OF RAW MILK IS NOT LIMITED TO A SALE ON THE FARM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-59-248(b), concerning the incidental sale or advertising of raw goat milk, raw sheep milk, and whole milk that has not been pasteurized directly to consumers at the farm, is amended to read as follows:

*(b) This subchapter does not:*

*(1) Prohibit ~~prohibit~~ incidental sales of raw goat milk, raw sheep milk, and whole milk that has not been pasteurized directly to consumers;*

*(A) At ~~at~~ the farm where the milk is produced;*

*(B) At a farmer's market; or*

*(C) Via delivery from the farm where the milk is produced;*



or

(2) Preclude ~~preclude~~ the advertising of incidental sales of goat milk, sheep milk, and whole milk that has not been pasteurized.
