## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PROHIBITED CONTRACTS BY STATE AGENCIES; TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS BY STATE AGENCIES TO PURCHASE PROMOTIONAL ITEMS MADE IN CHINA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PROHIBITED CONTRACTS BY STATE AGENCIES; AND TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS BY STATE AGENCIES TO PURCHASE PROMOTIONAL ITEMS MADE IN CHINA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-1-1202, concerning the definitions for the laws on prohibited contracts by state agencies, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(5) "Public funds" means the same as defined in § 19-11-203;

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 1, Subchapter 12, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

25-1-1204. Promotional items made in China prohibited.

A state agency shall not spend public funds to purchase promotional items made in the People's Republic of China.

SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. The name of Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter
