AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE SPECIAL
AUTHORIZATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR
MEALS AND LODGING WHILE TRAVELING ON
OFFICIAL BUSINESS OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-903(a)(1), concerning standard reimbursements and special authorizations, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) Except for special authorization by the ~~Chief Fiscal Officer of the State~~ cabinet-level secretary, director, chief executive officer, or chief fiscal officer of the department, board, or commission for which the travel is incurred, reimbursement for meals and lodging while traveling on official business of the state shall not exceed the maximum rates as prescribed by the Federal Travel Directory published by the United States General Services Administration.
