OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING INSURANCE  
REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSED HOME  
INSPECTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-52-318(a), concerning the insurance requirements for a home inspector, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) ~~All home inspectors are~~ A home inspector is required to carry general liability insurance a professional liability insurance policy or an errors and omissions insurance policy approved by the State Insurance Department for the home inspections performed by the home inspector.

(2) Coverage limits shall be not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
