AN ACT TO PERMIT A RETIRING PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO
BE AWARDED HIS OR HER SERVICE FIREARM UPON
RETIREMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO PERMIT A RETIRING PROSECUTING
ATTORNEY TO BE AWARDED HIS OR HER
SERVICE FIREARM UPON RETIREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-21-147(b), concerning the powers of a prosecuting attorney and a deputy prosecuting attorney, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(5) When a prosecuting attorney or a deputy prosecuting attorney whom a prosecuting attorney has authorized to carry a firearm retires from service as a prosecuting attorney or deputy prosecuting attorney, in recognition of and appreciation for his or her service to the state may be awarded any firearm carried during his or her tenure as prosecuting attorney or deputy prosecuting attorney.
