AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING MICROBREWERY-
RESTAURANT PRIVATE CLUB PERMITS; TO AMEND THE LAW
REGARDING ADVERTISING BY A MICROBREWERY-RESTAURANT
PRIVATE CLUB; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING ADVERTISING
BY A MICROBREWERY-RESTAURANT PRIVATE
CLUB.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-5-1904(d)(2), concerning the prohibition on advertising by a microbrewery-restaurant private club, is amended to read as follows:

(2) The prohibition on advertising or promoting the consumption and use of alcoholic beverages under subdivision (d)(1) of this section does not apply to ~~a~~:

(A) A microbrewery-restaurant private club advertisement consisting solely of the name of the microbrewery-restaurant private club; or

(B) The use of social media, a website, or other electronic means to provide information to a consumer regarding the microbrewery-restaurant private club, including without limitation the location, events, and menu.
