HOUSE BILL 1710

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE SCHOOL RATING SYSTEM; TO PROHIBIT A SCHOOL FROM USING OR REFERENCING A PUBLIC SCHOOL RATING IN ANY ADVERTISING, PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL, OR COMMUNICATION DIRECTED TO THE PUBLIC; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT A SCHOOL FROM USING OR REFERENCING A PUBLIC SCHOOL RATING IN ANY ADVERTISING, PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL, OR COMMUNICATION DIRECTED TO THE PUBLIC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-2105, concerning the publication of a public school's rating by the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(c)(1) No school shall use or reference a public school rating of another school that is published by the division under this subchapter in any advertising, promotional material, or communication the school directs to the public.

(2) As used in subdivision (c)(1) of this section, "school" means a public school district, an open-enrollment public charter school, or a private school.
