### For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ADULT EDUCATION  
CHARTER SCHOOLS; TO AMEND THE FUNDING AVAILABLE TO  
ADULT EDUCATION CHARTER SCHOOLS; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE FUNDING AVAILABLE TO ADULT  
EDUCATION CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-23-1005 is amended to read as follows:

6-23-1005. Funding.

(a) Funding for an adult education charter school shall ~~not~~ be provided through the Division of Career and Technical Education Public School Fund Account of the Public School Fund.

(b) Funding for an adult education charter school may come from public or private sources, including from the eligible entity that operates an adult education charter school.

(c)(1) An adult education charter school shall receive per student a funding amount equal to the per-pupil foundation funding amount established under § 6-20-2305.

(2) An adult education charter school that receives funding under this section shall submit a report annually to the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education and the Legislative Council that includes:

(A) Data on graduation rates of students attending the adult education charter school; and



(B) Employment rates of students who were enrolled in the adult education charter school.

(3) The funding provided under this section shall be reviewed annually based upon a review of the report under subdivision (c)(2) of this section.
