WHEREAS, the Mountain Home Bombers boy's cross country team claimed the Class 5A state championship at Oaklawn in Hot Springs, Arkansas, on Thursday, November 7, 2024; and

WHEREAS, this was the third consecutive and seventh overall Class 5A state championship win for the Bombers; and

WHEREAS, the Bombers scored fifty-seven (57) points more than the runners-up, the Hot Springs Lakeside Rams; and

WHEREAS, Jackson Free won the individual title with a time of sixteen hours, six minutes, and seventeen seconds (16:06:17), and was one of five runners for the Bombers who made the All-State team; and

WHEREAS, of the four (4) other runners for the Bombers who made the All-State team, Conner King took third place, Garrett Barr took fourth place, Trenton Smith took sixth place, and Wave Simmons took nineteenth place at the state championship; and



WHEREAS, the Bomber boy's cross country team was led by coaches Wil Norris, Tilda Helgesson, and Roddy Patrick,
