WHEREAS, the values of the American Association of University Women, Central Arkansas Branch, are to be nonpartisan and fact-based, to act with integrity, and to honor inclusion and intersectionality; and



WHEREAS, the American Association of University Women first met in 1881 and has been a catalyst for positive change ever since, with more than one hundred seventy thousand (170,000) members and supporters today across the United States, one thousand (1,000) local branches, and over eight hundred (800) college and university partners; and

WHEREAS, the American Association of University Women examines and takes positions on the fundamental issues of the day, encompassing educational, social, economic, and political issues,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House of Representatives recognize the American Association of University Women, Central Arkansas Branch, for advancing gender equity for women and girls through research, education, and advocacy.
