WHEREAS, the Energy Council was established in 1975 as a nonpartisan forum for legislators in Arkansas, Texas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and New Mexico to learn about and collaborate on energy policy and issues relevant to their constituents; and

WHEREAS, the Energy Council has expanded to include fourteen (14) member states and the Canadian provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan that actively participate in the development of state and federal energy and environmental policy; and

WHEREAS, the Energy Council helps to inform lawmakers about economic markets and emerging technology and practices relating to an evolving energy landscape; and



WHEREAS, the members of the Energy Council utilize their knowledge of global trends and policies to formulate effective policy and foster a comprehensive understanding of energy and the environment; and
