SENATE BILL 141

AN ACT TO ELIMINATE FUNDING TO THE ARKANSAS CENTER
FOR HEALTH IMPROVEMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO ELIMINATE FUNDING TO THE ARKANSAS
CENTER FOR HEALTH IMPROVEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

25-1-130. Funding of Arkansas Center for Health Improvement by state moneys prohibited – Definition.

(a) As used in this section, "state agency" means every department, division, office, board, commission, and institution of this state, including state-supported institutions of higher education and state-supported medical facilities.

(b)(1) No state moneys shall be used by a state agency to provide funding or grants or to enter into a contract with the Arkansas Center for Health Improvement.

(2) A state agency that provides funding or grants or enters into a contract with the Arkansas Center for Health Improvement shall execute a written certification that no state moneys are being used for the funding, grant, or contract.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. Application.

(a) This act does not apply to a contract using state moneys entered



into before the effective date of this act.

(b) A contract under subsection (a) of this section shall not be renewed using state moneys.
