AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ELECTION AUDITS;
TO ALLOW THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO
AUDIT A COUNTY IN THE PRECEDING ELECTION IN CERTAIN
CIRCUMSTANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ELECTION
AUDITS; AND TO ALLOW THE STATE BOARD OF
ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO AUDIT A COUNTY
IN THE PRECEDING ELECTION IN CERTAIN
CIRCUMSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-4-121(a)(2)(A), concerning the duties of the State Board of Election Commissioners during a post-election audit, is amended to read as follows:

(A)(i) Except as otherwise provided in subdivision (a)(2)(A)(ii) of this section, ~~Select~~ select by lot the counties, polling sites, early voting locations, and vote centers to be audited.

(ii) If a county in the immediately preceding preferential primary election or general election is found to have less than one hundred percent (100%) accuracy in the State Board of Election Commissioners audit, the county shall be chosen for audit in the subsequent preferential primary election or general election;
