For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ACCESS TO RECORDS OF THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION CENTER; TO ALLOW DISCLOSURE TO A JUDGE OF INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION CENTER BY THE OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT OR CRIME VICTIMS REPARATIONS BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO ALLOW DISCLOSURE TO A JUDGE OF INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION CENTER BY THE OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT OR CRIME VICTIMS REPARATIONS BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-211(b)(3)(A), concerning the release of information by the Arkansas Crime Information Center to the Office of Child Support Enforcement or to the Crime Reparations Board, is amended to read as follows:

(3)(A) It shall be unlawful for any person to disclose information obtained under this subsection except:

- (i) For the purpose of performing the duties of the:
 - (a) Office of Child Support Enforcement of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration; or
 - (b) Crime Victims Reparations Board; ~~or~~
- (ii) Upon court order; or



(iii) To a district court judge, circuit court judge, Judge of the Court of Appeals, or Justice of the Supreme Court upon request.
